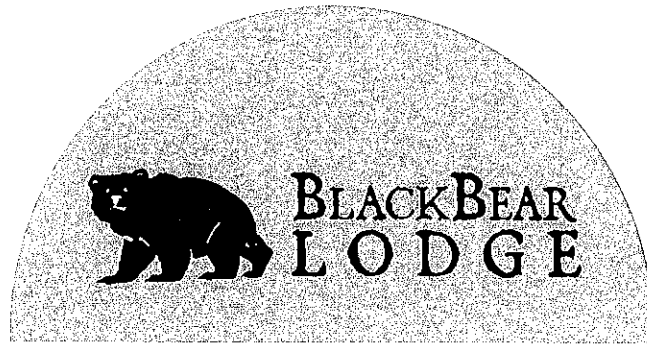

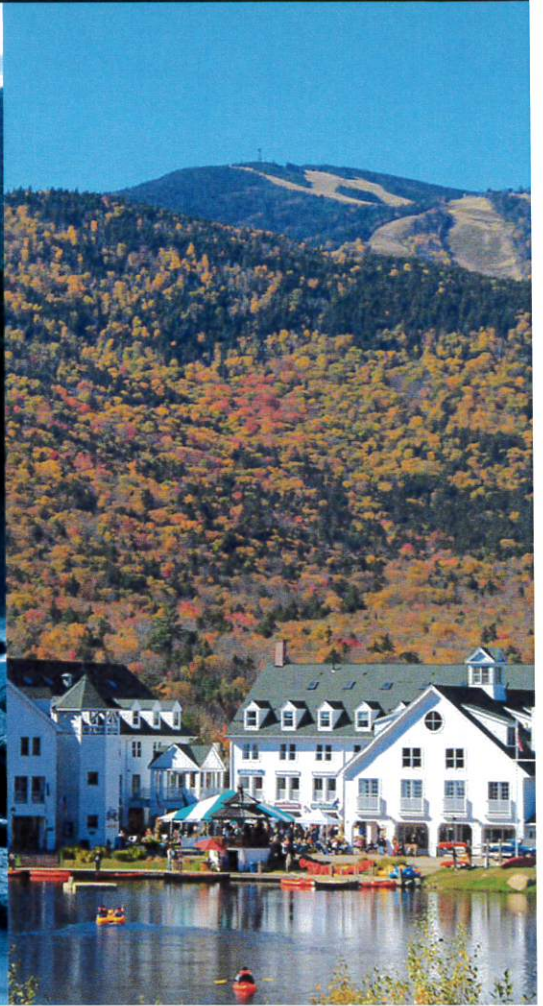
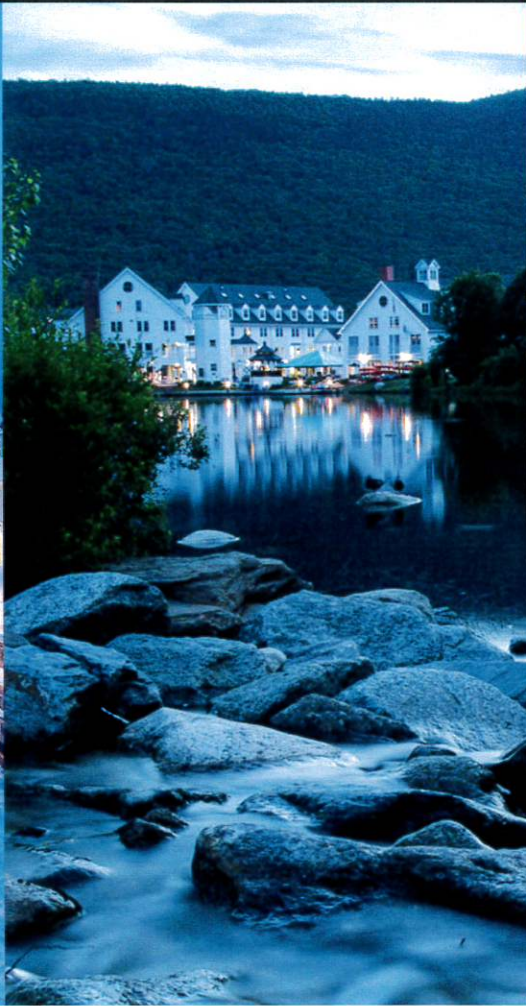

ABOUT WATERVILLE VALLEY

The quaint, New England village center of Waterville Valley, NH is located on the valley floor, surrounded on all sides by 4,000 foot peaks, the classic alpine square boasts views of Mt. Tecumseh ski trails and overlooks the beautiful Corcoran Pond. A hub of summer events, visitors, locals, and staff gather for live music on the Gazebo Stage, food festivals, and outdoor activities for all ages. Pedal boats, kayaks, and paddle boards can be rented right from the dock or head over to the beach to stick your toes in the sand or watch an outdoor movie. Rent a road or mountain bike from the Adventure Center to explore the valley, or set up camp with your open containers at a nearby picnic table. Shops and restaurants surround the square with lodging available on the upper level, boasting some of the best views in town. When flakes start to fall come Winter, Town Square transforms into a Winter Wonderland, with a twinkling tree, cozy outdoor fire pit, Nordic activities and ice skating. The best part? A shuttle bus will take you anywhere in the valley or up to the slopes for free so you can experience everything Waterville Valley Resort has to offer!



WATERVILLE VALLEY HISTORY

Since the mid-19th century, Waterville Valley has been a noted resort in the White Mountains. Fishermen were first attracted to the area's trout streams and resided in local farmhouses until Nathaniel Greeley provided bed and board and later built an inn for the growing number of guests. Until the early 1930's, only summer visitors returned annually to enjoy tennis, golf, and the beauty and healthiness of this mountain environment. In the mid 30's, America's interest in the sport of skiing began to take hold. Mt. Tecumseh first attracted hearty skiers in 1934 who climbed the mountain to ski on old logging roads. In 1936, the Waterville Inn remained open throughout the winter for the first time to accomodate this new breed of recreationist.

Following World War II, business flourished at the Waterville Inn. By 1952, T-Bar ski lifts were operating on Snow's Mountain. The potential of Mt. Tecumseh was not fully recognized until former Olympic skier, Tom Corcoran, officially purchased the Waterville Inn and 425 acres of inn property on the valley floor in 1966.

Clearing the trails on Tecumseh began in February 1966 and the area opened in December with two main lifts to the top- White Peaks and High Country. Later that winter, the Waterville Inn was destroyed by fire, 99 years after its initial opening. This presented an opportunity born out of necessity for Corcoran's Waterville Company to implement a thorough resort development plan.

Over 25 years of carefully planned resort expansion, country inns, lodges, condominiums, a multi-million dollar indoor sports center, a man-made pond, and many other amenities and services were added. The beautiful "hub" of Waterville Valley, Town Square, with its old New England style architecture was completed in 1989 and contains most of the Valley's dining, shopping, and entertainment. Waterville Valley has also become internationally famous for being among the elite in hosting many World Cup ski racing events.

LODGE RULES

1 NO SMOKING

Smoking or vaping of any kind is not allowed inside the building. Smoking is allowed outside- 25 feet away from the building.

2 PETS

Pets are not allowed at the Black Bear Lodge with the exception of service animals. Proper identification for a service animal is required upon check-in.

3 REGISTERED GUESTS ONLY

No visitors after 10pm. Visitors must notify Front Desk upon their arrival & must be accompanied by a registered guest at all times. Visitors are not allowed to use guest amenities including the hot tub, pool, exercise room, or WIFI. As a registered guest, you are responsible for your visitor at all times.

4 QUIET HOURS DAILY FROM 10PM-8AM

Quiet Hours in the Black Bear Lodge are observed daily from 10:00pm until 8:00am the following day. For the sake of our residents, we ask that you observe the Quiet Hours. Quiet Hours are strictly enforced. If you become aware of a disruptive guest, please contact the Front Desk immediately by phone or in person. TVs, voices, or other devices must be kept at a respectful, low level at all times. Doors should be opened and closed quietly. No congregating or running in halls.

5 DAMAGE TO PROPERTY & FURNISHINGS

Please take good care of the condo and its furnishings and appliances as well as the common areas and amenities of the lodge. Each condo is owned by an individual or family who has taken great care to personally furnish, decorate, and equip their condo for the comfort of our guests. If anything is not working or breaks during your stay in either your unit or in the common areas of the lodge, please alert the front desk immediately. Upon check-in we will place a \$200 hold on a credit card for each room reserved that will be released after a post-check-out room inspection confirms there are no missing or damaged items.

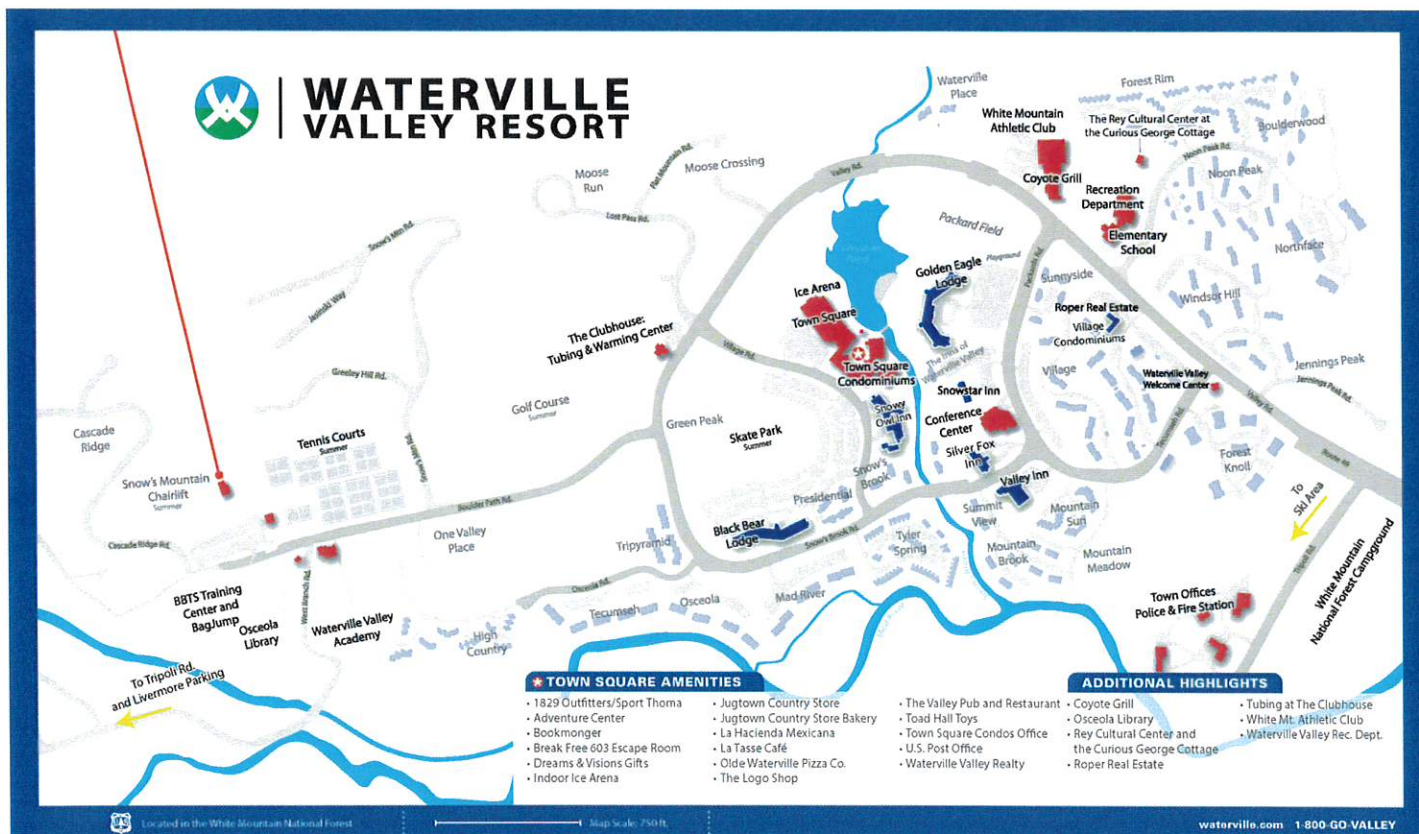

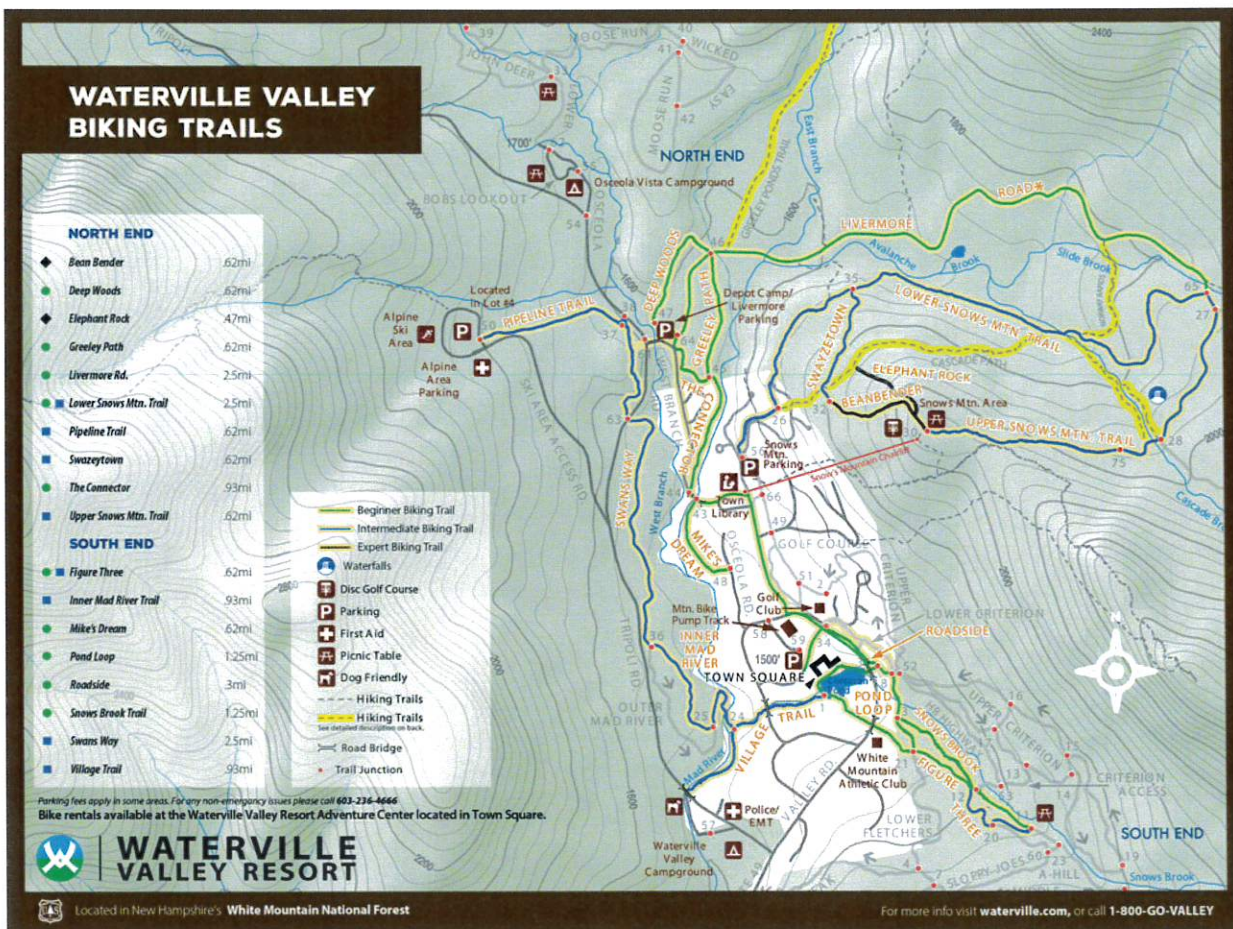
WV RESORT SUMMER MAP



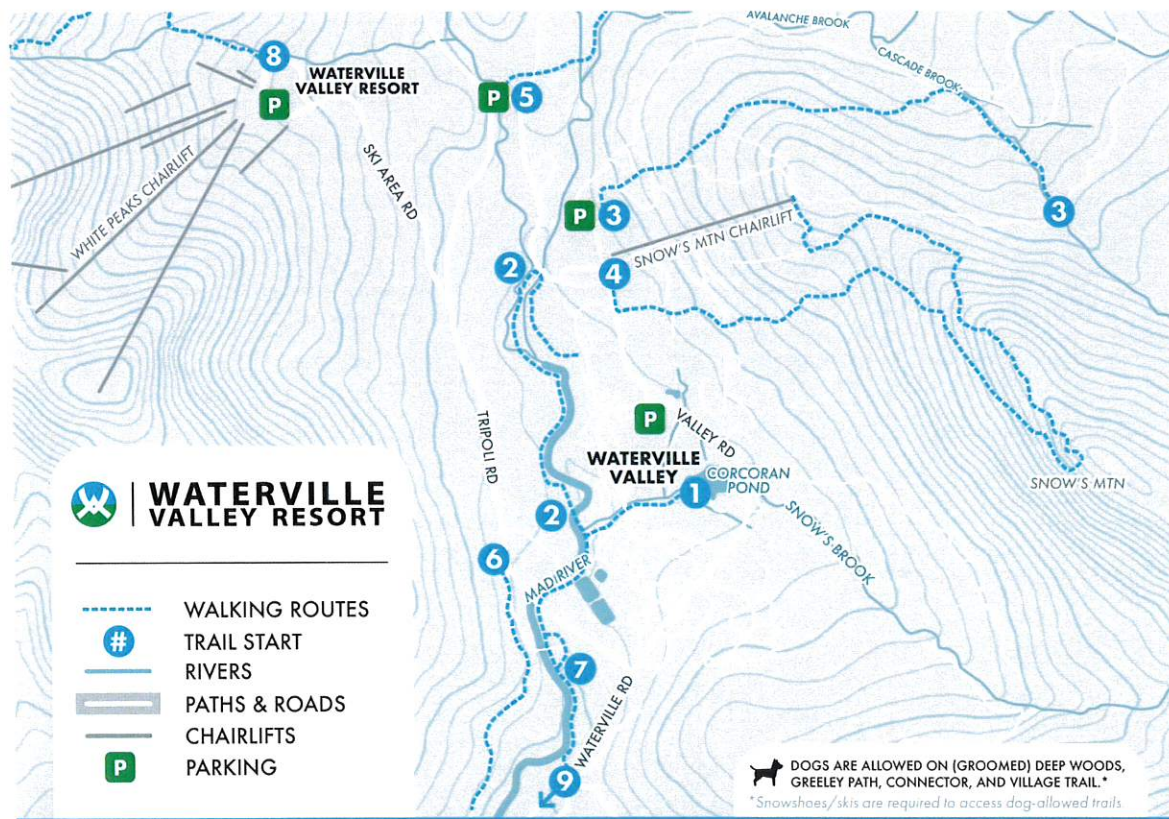
WV RESORT WINTER MAP

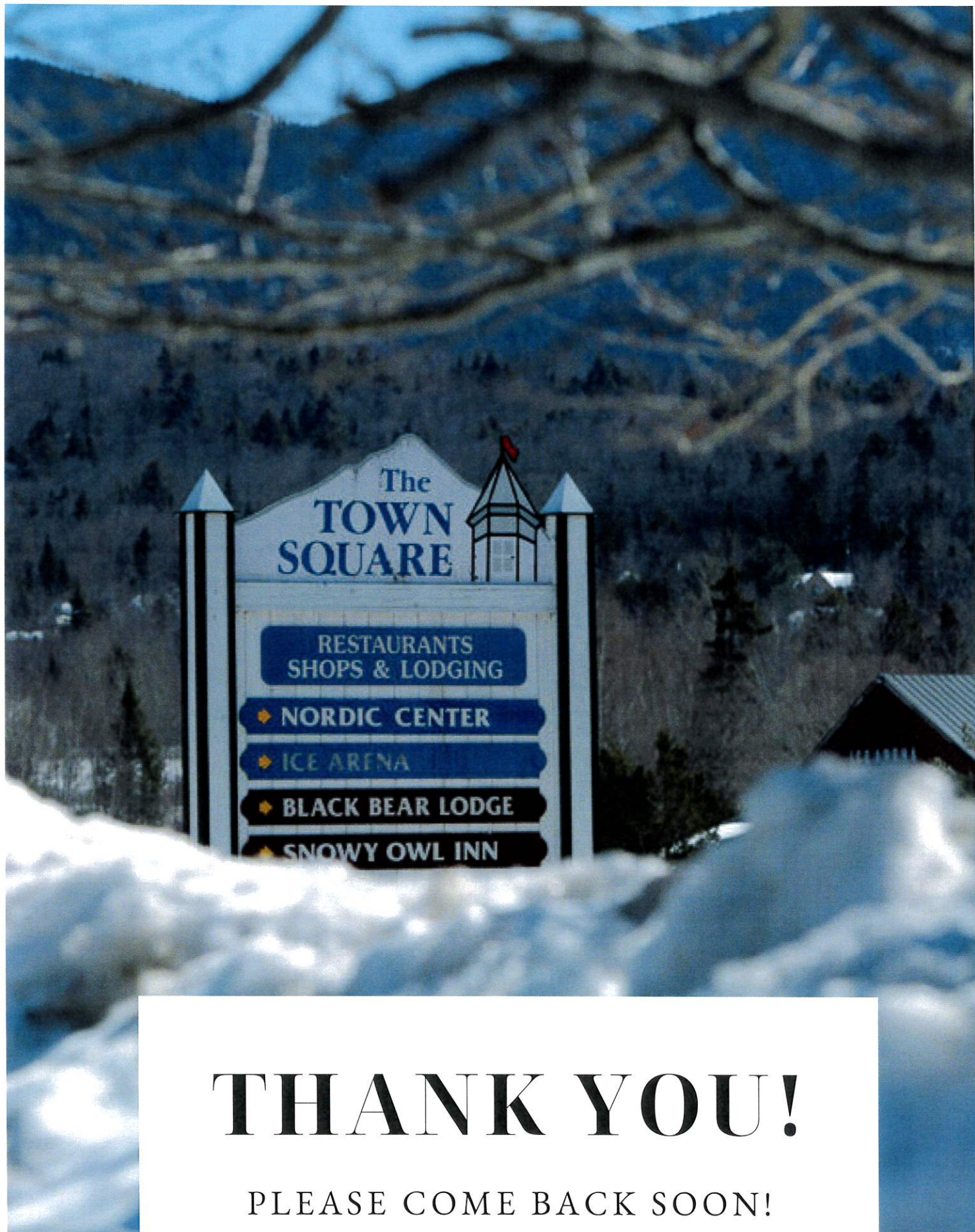


WV RESORT HIKING/BIKING MAP



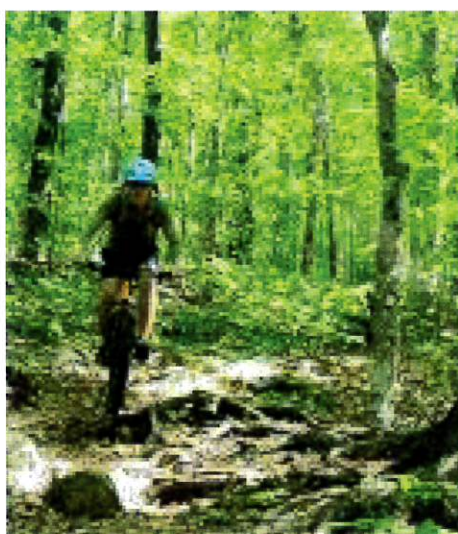
WV RESORT WINTER WALKING MAP
